


Building a Skilled Home Care Workforce

The SEIU 775 Benefits Group is the nation's leading training provider for Home Care Aides, training more than 45,000 Home Care Aides annually. 
Benefits Group Apprenticeship Program Recognized by White House, Department of Labor



White House Recognition

White House recognized the Benefits Group's Training Partnership Apprenticeship Program in April 2014 and in a report in June 2014 for innovation and leadership in job training:

In April, the White House highlighted the Training Partnership's plans to partner with several employers of home care workers in Washington ... and its stated goal of expanding its apprenticeship program for home care workers over the next five years"



DOL Trailblazer and Innovator Award

The U.S. Department of Labor recognized the Benefits Group as a "Trailblazer and Innovator" for its ground-breaking Registered Apprenticeship program.
